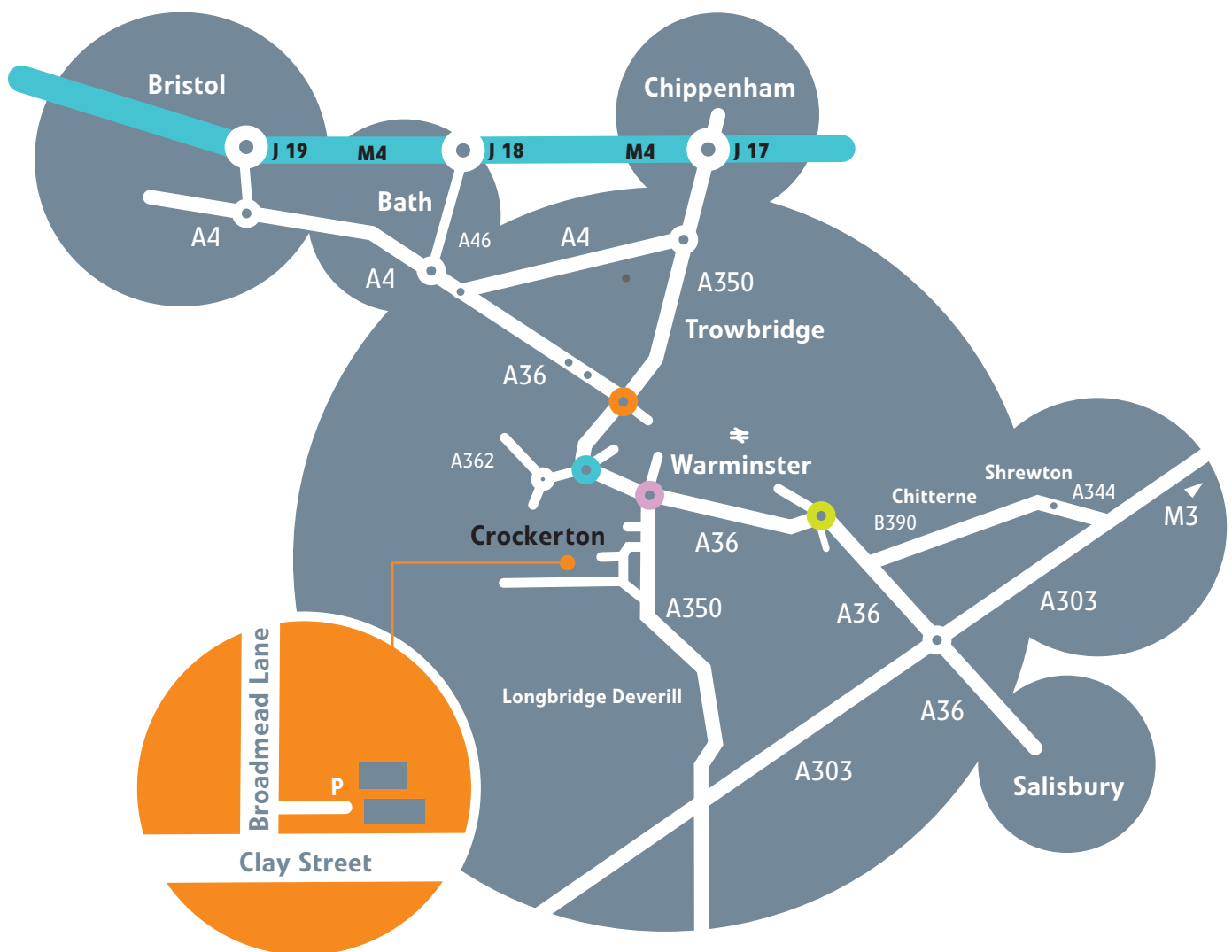


How to find us



Directions from the East, A303 & M3

Travel time (by road) from Salisbury to Crockerton: approx 45 mins From Central London: approx 2.5 hours.

Leave the M3 at Junction 8, then merge onto the A303. Continue past Andover until you reach Stonehenge exit. Turn right onto the A344 which then joins into the A360 and continue until you reach Shrewton. At the mini roundabout bear left. On leaving the village take the first turning on the left, across Salisbury Plain towards Chitterne (B390). Pass through the village until you reach the A36 junction at Hook Army Camp. Turn right at this junction onto the A36 and continue until you reach the Heytesbury roundabout.

- Take the second exit continuing on the A36 until you reach the next roundabout.
- Take the first exit left signposted Longbridge Deverill, Blandford and Poole (A350). Continue for 500 metres and take the second turning on the right, signposted Potters Hill. The road bears around to the left and after 100m you will reach a fork in the road, continue left (not up Potters Hill) along Paradise Lane. Turn next right into Clay Street, signposted Shearwater and Maiden Bradley, with the Bath Arms pub on the right. After 500m, turn right into Broadmead Lane and then immediately right to Broadmead House. At the end of the tree lined drive we have a visitors parking area. The studio is situated at the end of the gravel drive, to the right of the main house.
